The position is based at CIMMYT's campus in Texcoco, State of Mexico, located 45 km northeast of Mexico City, Mexico.

### Specific duties:

- Contribute to improve data analysis methods, techniques and procedures.
- Contribute to training activities.
- Contribute to the research activities of the unit; analyze data and develop new knowledge.

- Advanced level of English. English will be tested and candidate should score a minimum of C1 on CEFR.
- High level of responsibility, confidentiality and discretion.
- The selected candidate must exhibit the following competencies: Communication, Problem Solving, Pro-Activity, Teamwork, Innovation and Creativity and Customer Orientation.
